

Info from Mahea (Aug 18, 1974) who learned it mostly from Laukava and Sala ca. 1931-32.

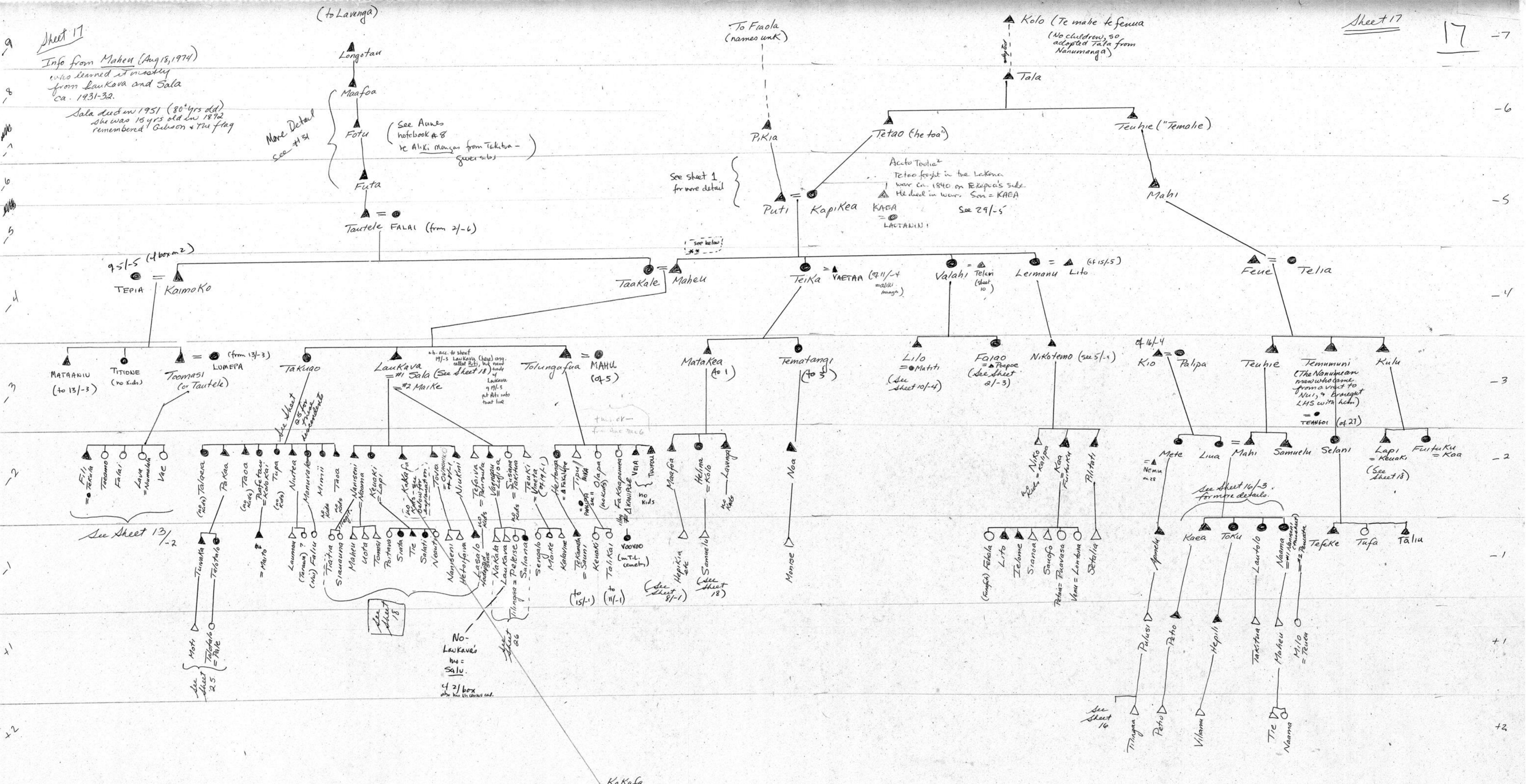
Sala died in 1951 (80 yrs old) she was 15 yrs old in 1872 remembered Gibson + the flag

Acuto Taulia? Tetoo fought in the Lakona war ca. 1840 on Fakipoo's side. He died in war. Son = KAFA See 29/5



Kakafa
 Kakafa was very angry with Laukava, his father, when the latter divorced Sala. To vent his anger, he cut his stomach open, so the guts hung out & danced around. He was able to find the strength to cut himself like this because of magic he had inherited thru Sala from Takua. His guts were stuffed inside & sealed up, but he died about 3 days later.

** Note on this Atiki message. [31 main #4] There is some disagreement, but Susana [Takitua's wife] gave her 'kepi' [1973] as Pakeilon. [31st Laukava's dau]. I think other have given some 'Kopise'. Another name given by Hetafiva and Nakala is 'Fakavekave'.
